Item - It is also enacted, established, and ord. in. by the Community aforesaid that the Clerk of this Court shall have and be paid him for the adjudgment of the age of every Swallow the summe of two shillings and six pence ster; or thirty pounds of tobacco to be paid by the Master of such Swallow as shall be adjudged. And that the Clerk shall have and be paid him for every order two shillings ster or twenty pounds of tobacco, and for every petition preferred to this Court, two shillings and six pence ster; or thirty pounds of tobacco. all which fees, and other fees that shall or may be any way due to the Clerk of this Court, shall be recovered by way of execution upon the Body goods or Chattels of such person or persons from whom the same shall or may be due.

Item - It is further enacted established and ord. in. that the Constable of St. Maries City do: live on every Sunday (that is today, once in the morning and once in the afternoon) go: up and down, & search the for all Ordinaries within the City and liberties thereof to see what Rules and Orders are kept, and shall at every Mayors Court here for the said City, present and certify upon Oath what Rules and Orders are kept in any either or all of the said Ordinaries on Sunday or Sabbath day as aforesaid.

Item - It is further Ord. in. established and enacted as aforesaid, that if any the Ordinary keep within the City or liberties thereof presume to sell any manner of liquor w: soever by any other measure than what shall be proportionable to the measure, that are abroad stamped and allotted as a Standard for the City, and w: are in the custody of Mr. John Baker, that he, she, or they presuming so to do shall be deemed to sell liquor by false measure, and is guilty of the breach of the Act of Assembly relating to Ordinary keepers, and the Court will take advantage against them as is mentioned in the said Act.

Item - It is further enacted ord. in. established that no person or persons whatsoever presume to keep Ordinaries within the said City of St. Maries or liberties thereof, without license from the Court first had and obtained, Any person so presuming as aforesaid, shall be deemed an Ordinary keeper without license and committed to the prison of the act of Assembly in that case made and provided.

Item - Whereas Complaint hath been made to this Court by several Inhabitants of the said City of the very great damage and mischief that are done by Hogs kept within the said City or liberties
