

Judge it necessary in our name to prorogue, or otherwise to dissolve
 at his said Deputies pleasure. And likewise for us and in our
 name and in our absence from our Province, to ordain, make
 and enact by and with the advice, assent and approbation of any
 such assembly or assemblies so called assemblies or summonies
 as aforesaid Laws, orders of the said Province, until we our self or our
 Heirs and Assigns, Lords and Proprietary, Lords & Proprietors
 of the said Province shall declare or publish, or cause to be
 declared or published within our Province, our his or their
 or some of their special dissent or dissent, disagreement or
 disagreement to the same and our his or their or some of their
 State or States; So as the said Laws and Acts so to be
 ordained, made and enacted be conformable to reason, and be not
 repugnant or contrary, but as near as reasonably may be
 agreeable to the Laws, Statutes and Customs of the Kingdom
 of England, and so as the same be not void, repugnant unto or
 destructive of our rights, privileges or jurisdictions, or to the
 Disinheritance of us our Heirs and Assigns, Lords & Proprietors
 of the said Province, or contrary to our or their power, government
 or Dominion, or contrary to a certain Act of Assembly heretofore
 made in the Ninth year of the Dominion of our deceased
 Father of Noble memory Charles the First King of Great Brittain
 hundred and fifty five [An Act concerning Religion]
 And likewise we do further give and grant unto our Dear
 Son during the time of his Exercise of the said Office hereby
 granted unto him, full power and Authority from him to him by
 his Deputies to make, constitute, ordain, and publish in our Name
 such articles, laws, reasonable, and profitable Ordinances, Edicts,
 and Proclamations within our Province, for the better
 governing of the people in our Province, and with such reasonable
 pains and penalties as he therein shall see fit, as we our self may
 lawfully do being personally present in our Province. Willing
 and hereby requiring that all the above mentioned powers and
 Authority by these presents given and granted to our Dear Son
 be from him to him as occasion shall require, exercised performed
 and executed for our Dear Son (by reason of his being absent)
 by our trusty and well beloved Counsellor Thomas Tailor Esq.
