 the good Governanc: and ordering of all affaires relating to y^e
 same in our s^d Province during our pleasure. And we do
 further assigne constitute and appoint that they the said Thomas
 Faullo, Vincent Love, Henry Darnall, William Digger, William
 Stiven, William Burger, Nicholas Swall, Edward Lye,
 Thomas Truman and Vincent Hill or any three or more of them,
 (of which we will that the said Henry Darnall, William
 Digger, and Nicholas Swall or any two or one of them
 be always present) shall in our absence be full sufficient
 and lawful Council for the ends and purposes aforesaid
 willing and by the said persons requiring and firmly enjoyning
 all persons of our s^d Province and Dominions aforesaid, that
 in all things relating to the premises they give obedience unto
 our s^d Council, and to all such ord^s and Commands as shall from
 time to time be made and given by our s^d Council, or any three
 or more of them (of which the said Henry Darnall, William
 Digger, and Nicholas Swall, or any two or one of them to be
 always present) so: as such ord^s and Commands be consonant
 to reason, and be not repugnant or contrary unto, but as much
 as conveniently may be agreeable to and with the Lawes
 Statutes and customs of the Kingdom of England; And we do
 hereby revoke repeal annulle and make void all and every
 former Commission and Comissions, Letters Patentes, Orders and
 Authorities whatsoever by us at any time heretofore formally
 given, for the erecting creating constituting or appointing of a
 privy Council within our said Province or the Dominions
 thereto belonging, or for the creating or appointing any person or
 persons to be of our private secrett or continuall Council the
 same.
