Now time was read and heard a Petition presented to the Council
by Cap^t John Quigley being as follows

To the R^{ts} Hon^{rs} Charles Lord Baltimore absolute Lord
and Prop^r of the Province of Maryland & Avalon

The Humble Petition of John Quigley of the Colony of Virginia

Sheweth Unto yo^r L^{ts} that yo^r Petitioner being out of this Province his Kinsman, and
Attorney John Derry of St. Marys City Inholder & partner this last making
his Sister Elmore Derry, his Brother Owen Quigley, and yo^r L^{ts} his
Kinsman, his Execut^r and gav^e us all that he had, the said Elmore Derry and
Owen Quigley having never been in this Province, and yo^r L^{ts} being absent
in Garratt Vanw^ruigen of the City of St. Maries Inholder that way
really and bona fide ind^{ed} to the said Derry at the time of his Death,
pretending himself a Cred^r to the said Derry to the Judge for payment of Will^{ts}
and that the said Derry did subscribe, procured of the Judge nomination of
the said Derry's Estate as of an Inholder, Afterw^h yo^r L^{ts} arrived in this
Province, and understanding that the said Derry made such Will^{ts} yo^r L^{ts} exhibited
a Will^{ts} before the said Judge ag^t the said Garratt for the vacating the said nomination &
proving the said Will^{ts} the Judge upon hearing the cause pronounced the said Derry
did subscribe, and dismissed the said nomination with costs ag^t yo^r L^{ts} from w^h said
sentence of the said Judge yo^r L^{ts} appealed to yo^r L^{ts} in yo^r Court of
Chancery as by Law he might, Up^{on} yo^r L^{ts} according to the Statute of the 25th
Hen^{ry} 8th cap^{ts} 19th did by a Comiss^{rs} and your great Seal appoint and empower
Baker Brooks, Henry Cursey, Thomas Taylor, and Benjamin Forster Esq^{rs} to
be Comiss^{rs} and a Court of Delegates, for the rehearing and determining
determining such cause. The said Delegates having in Ob^{edi}ance to yo^r L^{ts}
