His Excellency is pleased to communicate to the Board the happy Success and Victory lately obtained by their Majestys forces at Sea and Land against the French and proposed a day of thanksgiving to be set apart and appointed for the same throughout the Province, which was unanimously approved of, and ordered that Proclamation issue accordingly thereby requiring all Persons duly and solemnly to observe and keep the same by their due acknowledgment to Almighty God in their devotions for so great a blessing, and otherwise to express their Joy in such decent ways and methods as in such Cases is usuall that Thursday next be appointed for Solemnization thereof, in the City of S^t Marys, thursday sevennight following for the County of S^t Marys, and the next thursday after throughout the rest of the Province
