Upon Consideration whereof Resolved and it is the opinion of this Board that they are sufficiently qualified and empowered to distribute and dispose of the said sum as they shall see convenient for the satisfaction of such Persons as have not been satisfied so far forth as the same will extend to: Ordered that M^r Henry Denton do calculate from his Journal what deductions have been made out of the severall Acco^{ts} to them exhibited, and what reference made to the next Assembly

Ordered that the French man lately taken from ^{among} the strange Indians at the head of the Bay and suspect for a spy being in custody and nothing more appearing against him be acquitted and released.
