Greene of Somerset County *(with greeting)*

Whereas I am credibly informed and complaint hath to me
been made, that severall Persons Inhabitants of Pennsylvania
and other our Neighbouring Colonies and Plantations do
annually at a certain Season of the Year come unto intrench
and encroach upon and within the limits and bounds of this
Province at the Sea-board Side, as whole men and do there seize
cut up and dry the blubber of drift whales, and carry away the
same without Leave License or consent of me or any other person
thereunto authorised so to do, to my particular apparent loss
damage and injury and in contempt of this their Majestys Govern-
ment as also to the disturbance and prejudice of the Inhabitants
of this Province, who in right and justice ought rather prin-
cipally to be employed therein by coming upon their Land
disturbing & driving away their Stocks, and destroying their
Woods and timber, which to prevent for the future, I the said
