

Upon motion made to the Board in behalf of a Party of Men in Arms under the Command of Cap^t Richard Brightwell, Rangers appointed on the Frontiers by order of his Excellency & continued from the 2^d day of April last to the last day of Nov^r 1760 concerning the Major part of their pay due to them for their Service and omitted to be allowed them by the Assembly viz^t a Captain and Eleven men with their Horses the Captains pay at 1300^{l. 10s} p^r mo and the Eleven men at 600^{l. 10s} each month

Ordered that the same be recommended to the consideration of the next Assembly to allot them their pay and that in the mean time a sumance be given and certified from this Board to Major Minton Beal High Sheriff of Talbot County to be also communicated and made known to those men that the full rem^d of their pay shall be duly awarded them in the next publick Levy and made good to them or their order whoever shall give them credit so that the whole pay rem^d due to the men deducting out of each mans proportion 160^{l. 10s} part already allowed them by the Assembly amounts to 39840^{l. 10s} and the Capt pay deducting 4000^{l. 10s} already allowed him amounts to 43440^{l. 10s} in all - 44180^{l.} tobacco the List of the Men delivered in is as follows viz^t
