I have thought fit by and with the Advice and consent of their Majestys Councille within this Province to defer and prorogue the same Assembly and the same is accordingly hereby further Prorogued & Deferred until the 20<sup>th</sup> day of May next Ensuing the date hereof. Wherof all and singular the Sheriffs of this Province are hereby straightly charged and commanded to make publick proclamation in the most publick and convenient places within their <sup>and respective</sup> severall Counties and also give notice to such of their Majestys Councille as Inhabit and reside within their respective Countys as to the Delegates and Deputys thereof by the Freemen of the same thereunto elected and chosen and that all Excuses set apart they & every of them be and personally appear at the City of S<sup>t</sup> Marys on the said Twentieth day of May next to do and consent to such things as shall then and there by the Favour of God happen to be obtained and Enacted.

Given at the City of S<sup>t</sup> Marys the Ninth day of March Anno Domini 1692 in the fifth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord and Lady King William and Queen Mary
