Yours of the 13th February last to his Excellency
the Governor he hath been pleased this day to communicate to the
Board wherein we take notice of the encroachment of some For-
eign Indians upon the Frontiers of the Province and their
insolent Carriage among the Inhabitants have consulted of the
most proper expedient to redress the same and to prevent the
like or worse for the future as by the Bearer Mr Tho^s Blake
you will be more fully informed we must entreat your assistance
and the rest of the Gentlemen in Commission there for your advice
and Directions to him and Coll Stearn in the management
of the Commission to them directed and the Powers & Authorities
therein granted you are also desired to use your best endeavours
to Inform your self and consequently those two Gentlemen with
the true nature nation and quality of those Indians their Busi-
ness and Pretences there in those Parts, and their Behaviour
since their Coming and also to procure and provide them with
such Evidences and testimonies as may be had to Prove the same
