The said P<sup>r</sup>ye is ordered to procure and give in a List of what Arms were in his Custody and what Locks were by him delivered to said Pent with all convenient speed

Ordered that the Book of Laws and all other Books Records & Writings belonging to the Secretaries Office be forthwith lodged and remain in the Office as formerly they have done & nowhere else & that the Clerk of the Same do attend there at the Usual Hours with the Seal

Ordered also that Sir Thomas Lawrence deliver to the Clerks of this Board a true Copy of the Contract or Agreement between him & William Jaylard Clerk of the Provincial Court touching or concerning the Profits and Perquisites of the Office

Proposed and Offered to the Consideration of the Board the Raising of Fifty thousand pounds of tobacco in the publick Levary this Year for a Stock or Bank to be lodged for defraying the publick Charge upon this Emergency of treating with and Providing against any attempts of the Indians and it is accordingly resolved that the said Sum be raised for the use aforesaid and that Orders for the Levying thereof be directed to the Severall Sheriffs of the Province by an equal Usefraint upon the Inhabitants with a Stay of Execution and not to lay the same till further Ord

Ordered that Coll Ninion Beal of Salvert County do afford all necessary aid and assistance to Coll Nicholas Greenberry and all other Persons concerned in the erecting and setting up the severall Forts by this Board this day agreed on, and that he be requested and required from this Board so to do

Ordered also that the Neighbouring Govern<sup>r</sup>s of New York & Virginia be also made acquainted with the foregoing U<sup>o</sup>rd & proceedings of this Board concerning the Foreign Indians & that his Exc<sup>ty</sup> the Governior be humbly desired to perform the same by way of Letter
