At a Court held at Hunting Town the 7th day of February
In the Year of our Lord God one Thousand six Hundred
Ninety and Two and in the 5th Year of the Reign of our
Sovereign Lord and Lady King William & Queen Mary
by the Grace of God King and Queen of England, Scotland
France & Ireland Defenders of the Faith &c by the Jus
tices thereunto authoursed & appointed together with the
most Principal Freeholders thereunto called for the laying
out of Parishes on the West Side of Pottuxent River in
Calvert County in obedience to an Act of Assembly Intitu
led an Act for the Service of Almighty God and the Estab
lishment of the Protestant Religion in this Province made at
the City of St Marys the 10th day of May Anno Dom 1692
