At a Court held at Benedict Leonard Town the 14th day of February in the Year of our Lord God one Thousand Six Hundred Ninety and two and in the fifth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord and Lady King William and Queen Mary by the grace of God King and Queen of England Scotland France and Ireland Defenders of the Faith &c by the Justices thereunto authorised and appointed together with the most Principal Freeholders thereunto called for the laying out of Parishes on the East Side of Pattuxen River in Salvert County being in Obedience to an Act of Assembly Intituled an Act for the Service of Almighty God and the Establishment of the Protestant Religion in this Province made at the City of St Marys the 10th day of May Anno Dom 1692
