That your Petitioner having lately purchased and so become lawfully seized in a certain tract or Parcell of Land called Joseph's mannor lying in Calvert County but the meetes and bounds thereof being therefore very uncertain Your Petitioner therefore humbly supplicates this Honble Board to grant him warrant of Resurvey of the same to be made in the presence of the Sheriff of the said County and the directions of a Jury of the Neighbourhood therein best known to be by the said Sheriff Summoned Impanelled and sworn and that the Sheriff may have Power and Authority to summon and swear Evidences to adjust the Bounds of the said Land

And your Petitioner as in duty Bound shall pray &c

The petition granted and Ordered that special warrant issue forth of the Land Office for resurvey of the Land Above mentioned according to the true antient intended meetes and bounds thereof in the presence of the Sheriff of the County, and a Jury of the Neighbourhood
