Hermans upon the Mannor is called or goes by the Name of Mons Castene he is marked with the Letters MC upon his Breast he married two Indian Squaws hath one Daughter aged sixteen Years the said French man was a Trader in New England & it was the occasion of the Slughter or Death of many hundred Souls in New England the said Thompson was a Captive or Prisoner to the aforesaid French man and made his Escape and when the said Thompson hath a sight of the said Frenchman and he proves to be the same man as he thinks for he will discover more of the said French mans Villany taken this 4th of March 1692

Henry Thompson aged 21 Years or thereabouts saith when he was brought to the sight of the French Indian who was supposed to be Mons Castene of Pennobscott beyond Penequid upon oath taken before me Augustin Caspi Herman saith that he is not Mons Castene to the best of his knowledge but some other Person neither did he the said Henry Thompson ever report that he had any marks upon his breast as is reported and further saith not
