

now to say against the Legitimacy of this Prince for that the  
 matter was now apparent enough, all which Coll Digges com-  
 afterwards to <sup>Mr</sup> Marys affirmed, and further added that King  
 James had sent over Proclamations into England in print  
 which were publickly dispensed up & down & every where to  
 be seen therein declaring a Generall Free Pardon to all not  
 excepting Doctor Burnet, but only the Bishop of London &  
 to the Deponents best remembrance the Lord President &  
 further the Deponent told the said Turbiville / as he had heard  
 it related from said Fitzhugh & Coll Digges / that all things to  
 that end were agreed on between King James & his Friends  
 in England wherein amongst other things it was concluded on  
 that there should no Jesuits remain in England, but that the  
 King might exercise his Religion without molestation that  
 severall of quality & in Power both in England & in this Coun-  
 try did attend & wait the motion of King James' Landing  
 in England whereupon the Deponent questioned whom they  
 might be supposing it might be such as would not take the  
 Oaths tho' they were Protestants to which it was answered  
 him that unknown there were a great many such in England  
 that after the French Fleet was beaten and the Plot or Design  
 was discovered and did not take Effect there were several thous-  
 and of Houses found in England accounted for war, but no Body  
 durst own them & as for those Persons in the Country being  
 Protestants and Refusers of the oath they were many in Vir-  
 ginia, the Deponent further upon his oath saith that the said  
 Coll Digges told him that last Year to the best of this Depon-  
 Remembrance / one Capt Purvis should say that he expected  
 an Alteration before he got home and that this & the like Dis-  
 courses was very publickly talked on in Virginia & in England  
 without any notice taken thereof & that <sup>Mr</sup> Edmonde Andros  
 himself Governor of Virginia did in particular freely & openly  
 talk of the same among his Councill who also did the same
