His Excellency gives the Board to understand that he had seen the Copy of a Letter from the Queens Majesty requiring aid & assistance to New York to be given them from these three Neighbouring Colonies & plantations that in obedience therunto the Government of Virginia had already supplied them with 600 Stk he proposes & offers to deposit of his own money for & in Behalf of this Province the sum of three Hundred Pounds Sterl towards them further relief which is gratefully accepted & acknowledged by the Board as a favour & Ordered that the same as such be recommended to the next Assembly & left to their consideration here to Reimburse his Exc^{ty}
