

They to say on his Behalf therein do Request that upon the whole matter they do find the allegations & pretences of the said Morris to be altogether vain & fictitious, scandalous & ridiculous; whereupon the petition & the matter therein contained is dismissed the Board & the Court was discharged from their further attendance & the said Morris Ordered to pay them their Legal Charges.

M^r. Stephen Suff. Sheriff of Somerset County having by Virtue of a Warrant to him formerly directed for the apprehending & taking into his Custody of Edward Randolph Esq^r accordingly apprehended the said Randolph & suffered him to make his Escape is called on & charged with his Neglect therein & Ordered to give his Excellency an Account of the whole matter his manner of Proceedings & what had passed between him & the Governor of Virginia upon his application made to him in Order to retrieve his Prisoner which the said Stephen Suff. having accordingly done It is Ordered that he the said Stephen Suff. together with Charles Nicholson to attend him do again wait upon his Excellency to demand the delivery up to him of his Prisoner & that a Postscript be added to the Letter ordered to be drawn the 1st Instant to the said Gov^r to acquaint his Excellency that since the Writing thereof the said Sheriff was returned hither & had given an Account of his Demands made to his Excellency for the Surrender of the said Randolph his Prisoner & of his Excellency's answer thereto from whence this Board had been encouraged to request his Excellency the Governor of this Province to send back the said Sheriff together with the said Charles Nicholson in order to make a second demand & to hope his Exc^{ty} J^r Edward Andros would comply therewith.
