 fit to give them these following Instructions: viz

Instructions for Mr. Stephen Suttie & Mr.  
 Charles Nicholson to Virginia (viz)

You are to make Callend the motion of the heritable  
 Andrew Hamilton & Mr. Sherlock when they shall  
 think fit to set forth from hence into the Colony of  
 Virginia

With them you are to get Passage over the Land there  
 at such place where they shall think fit or may most  
 conveniently set you on shore

Upon your arrival there you are forthwith to apply your-  
 selves to the most likely & convenient places for procu-  
 ring Horses & a Guide if need be to conduct & Carry you  
 down to his Excellency the Gov. of that Country
