

Ordered by advice in Council that Proclamations be prepared to be signed by his Excellency's private Seal & transmitted to the several respective Counties of this Province to publish pronounce & declare the said Assembly to be dissolved. The same being prepared & signed & passed the private Seal and transmitted to the several Counties of the Province according to Order the tenor thereof running as follows viz

By his Excellency's Proclamation

Whereas the Gen^l Assembly of this Province begun & held at the City of St^l Marys the tenth day of May Anno Dom^o 1692 by writt from his Exc^{ty} the late Gov^l Lionel Cop^{pley} Esq^r deceased hath been by several Prorogations & adjourn^{ts} continued to the 20 day of this ^{Instant} September & the Chief Command & Government of this Province being now devolved upon me as Edmund Andros Esq^r by the Death of the said Lionel Coppley and the absence of Capt Francis Nicholson their Maj^{ty} Lieu^t Gov^l of this Province by their Majesty's Royal Commission to me Directed for that purpose I do by & with the advice of their Majesty's Council of this Province proclaim publish & make known that the said General Assembly is dissolved & the same is hereby in their Majesty's Names declared & pronounced accordingly to be dissolved wherof I do straightly charge & command all & singular the respective Sheriffs of the severall & respective Counties of this Province to make Publick Proclamation in the most publick & convenient places within their respective Counties for the General Information of all & singular their Maj^{ty} loving Subjects within this Province & to the End that all persons concerned may take due notice thereof & conform themselves accordingly
