In the Provincial Court for 1786. I Herd with Costs  
 of. Luce & the others served him with an execution for the  
 same upon which he was taken into custody of the Sheriff  
 of St. Marys County from whence he hath been illegally  
 discharged upon a supersedeas & writ of Error by him  
 repeatedly obtained with a design to deford & obstruct the  
 making satisfaction for the debt & costs of & the said  
 writ having upon former application to this board  
 lawfully obtained a order of the 25<sup>th</sup> of Aug<sup>r</sup> last for the said  
 Luce to file his errors against the said Judgment within  
 ten days of the date of the said Order & peremptorily to  
 come to a hearing & arguing of the same here at the beginning  
 of the Assembly the said Luce having in no wise comply  
 ed therewith the said Luce humbly prays the same may  
 be dismissed this Board & the said Luce again remaine  
 into custody until he have fully satisfied & discharged the  
 Judgment

Ordered that the same be dismissed this Board

The summons of Ann Hundell County being sum  
 mone to appear at the next provincial Court to answer for a  
 contempt alledged to have been committed by them in disobey  
 ing a precept or writ of habeas Corpus to them directed from  
 the Judges of the provincial Court at the Suite of John Liu  
 allen wherein they plead ignorance & humbly submit  
 themselves to the Clemency of his Excellency & pray to be dismissed  
 from their further attendance at the time appointed to their  
 Great Charge & detriment his Exc<sup>ty</sup> by & with the advice of the  
 Council is willing to dispence with & they are hereby remit  
 ted from their Attendance of & the penalties thereby accruing
