Upon signing a new Commission for the Post Court which here this day passed the Board but it being moved in Council whether the continuing of Coll<sup>o</sup> Blakiston in the absence of his Excellency might not occasion Disputes & it was resolved by the whole Board that it would be to their Maj<sup>ty</sup> Service & quiet of the Countrey that the said Coll<sup>o</sup> Blakiston was suspended & thereupon his Exc<sup>cy</sup> did in their Maj<sup>ty</sup> Names declare the said Coll<sup>o</sup> Blakiston suspended from further sitting & assisting in their Majesty's Council here

Mr Huseloyne being called up received his Commission for being Commissary here this day passed the Board but then likewise passed the Board the proclamation Yesterday Order to be drawn up being signed by his Exc<sup>cy</sup> & was as follows viz
