The which being read it was Ordered by advice of M^r Atty
Gen^l in Council that the said Captain John Addison & M^r
W^m Dent have Licence granted them according as they have
before prayed

Moved by a Member of this Board that Care be taken for a
pertaining some certain persons for sending away dispatches

Ordered thereupon by advice in Council that Geo Staker Esq^r
have hereby full power to press any Boat howe or Man upon
sudden emergencies as aforesaid for sending away dispatches
