mitted to the Land Office to be recorded

Thomas Martin of Talbot County humbly sets forth to this
Board that he is in Possession of a certain Tract of Land next
adjoyning upon a Tract formerly belonging to Richard Go-
such of the said County decd lying upon the dividing Creek
running out of Armstrongs Bay on the *Choptank River* in the
said County beginning at the said Gowuch Northernmost
Bounded Tree being a red Oak marked with four Notches
both said Tracts being parcels sold out of a Greater Tract
called *Shieder Loyd* & are luted & bounded as by the Certifi-
cates thereof remaining upon record among the Conveyances
of the said County but may more at large appear that he
has for these several years been molested & troubled by the *Tithe*
of the aforesaid Tract of Land of Gowuch by Trespassing as he
conceives within his bounds therefore humbly prays special
Warrant may issue directed to the Surveyor of that County
for the Resurveying of that aforesaid Tract of Land
of Gowuch by a Jury of Twelve Men of the Neighbourhood
for that end & purpose to be summoned & Sworn as in such
Case is usual according to the ancient meets & Bounds there-
of whereby he may find out the true Divisional Line betwixt
them & that if need shall require he might Resurvey his own
Land after the running forth of the other

Whereupon it was Ordered by advice in Council as it is hereby
Ordered that special Warrant issue according to the prayer
of the petitioner & that the present possessors of the said Land
of Gowuch have Notice given to be present at the said Resurvey
