The Council again sat & were present as Yesterday
 Upon representation here made in Council that one Richard
 Marsham of Salvest County had taken from him during
 the Revolution by Coll Beate of the said County four Guns
 & sixty four pound of shot & four pound of powder of all
 which restitution is humbly prayed it being urged that se-
 veral others in the same Nature have received the like Bene-
 fit or at least if Liberty will not be granted that all his
 Guns & Ammunition be restored it is further moved that
 the use of One may be granted him & leave given for to
 make sale of the rest that he may not too much suffer in
 this case Ordered therefore by advice as it is hereby
 Ordered that he the said Richard Marsham have the
 Liberty of taking his choice of any one of the aforesaid Guns
 to his own proper use & that the remaining three Guns to-
 gether with their powder & shot be lodged still where they are
 until the said Marsham can dispose & make sale of the
 same to his own advantage

Upon Representation & Motion made at this Board that
 the Court of Chancery is at present destitute of a Register & so
 the said that for want of such present Officer no Business
 in the said Court may be delayed or impeded —

Ordered by advice as it is hereby Ordered that Mr Will^m
 Taylard do for the time being supply the said vacancy of
 Register until further Order & that whereas the honorable Coll
 Mich Greenberry hath the Custody & Charge of the Great Seal
 of this Province committed unto him the said Coll Greenber-
 ry is therefore now in Council appointed Judge of the said
 Court & accordingly is to Commissionate Mr W^m Taylard
 Register as aforesaid & it is hereby further Ordered that all
 Writs thence issuing at the present be made returnable to
 the first day of the next Provincial Court of which all
 Persons concerned are to take strict Notice & yield due
 obedience thereunto
