

Which were accordingly produced & read unto them - they
 answered what Authority or power they have from their Com-
 mission to Act in that Affair upon which they appeared here &
 it is Answered they were sent from their Superior to know what
 is required of them & that they had no Power from their In-
 ferior to give any further Account save the knowing the
 demands of the Board - Resolved & Ordered thereupon as it
 is hereby Ordered that Capt^e John Addison together with the
 High Sheriff of Charles County Major James Smallwood &
 M^r John Stone meet at the house of M^r William Hutchin-
 son in the said County Wednesday next & from thence repair
 to the Empress of Piscataways Fort & there demand of the
 Emperor & his great men to surrender up the Indians being
 suspected about the aforementioned Murder together with
 the Murders pursuant to the Articles of Peace concluded
 with them by this Government in Order to be proceeded against
 according to Law & upon such surrender made to be Com-
 mitted to the Custody of the said Sheriff by him to be kept
 untill delivered by due Course of Law

Upon Representation ordered that Captain John Addison
 take care to raise five men and a Captain to range from the
 falls of Potomack to the falls of Patuxent or in other places
 where it shall be needful to make good against the
 Indians & that the said Rangers be placed where the said Cap^t
 Addison shall direct to be continued till the last of October

Ordered that Coll^o Mich Greenberry upon any occasion
 that shall seem to him meet & convenient have hereby full
 power to raise twelve Men viz Six in Ann Arundel County
 & six in Baltimore County to be employed to range according
 to the Directions of the said Coll^o Greenberry & to be continued
 as long as he shall see it fitful or necessary to be paid by the
 County
