Annapolis. July the 9th 1698

Memo that whereas his Majestys honorable Council was
appointed to meet at this place upon the 7th Instant, did not
according to the said Appointment, but Lieut Coll^o Henry
Low High Sheriff of St^e Marys County made Return to the
Clerk of this Board of the Sumpt he had to apprehend
Mr John Good Sen^r Mr Gerard Slye Mr Rob^t Mason
Mr Philip Clark &c viz^t

That by Virtue thereof he had taken the Body of Mr
Gerard Slye of St^e Marys County & Mr Sam Cooksey
but that as to Mr John Good he was fled Mr Philip Clark
absconded & Mr Robert Mason was languishing

And his Excellency the Governor being by the Clerk of
the Council made acquainted therewith and that Lieut Coll^o
Low had brought Mr Gerard Slye to town together with Mr
Cooksey

His Excellency ordered the Clerk of the Council to
require Lieut Coll^o Low that he required him immediately
bring Mr Slye before him
