And I do hereby publish & give notice to all per-
sons whatsoever that they do not presume to harbour &
Entertain any Saylor whatsoever unless those procuring
such Certificate & pass as aforesaid Given at the Town
& Port of Annapolis under the great Seal of this Prov:
the 22 day of July in the Tenth year of the Reign of
Our Sovereign Lord William the Third by the Grace of
God of England Scotland France & Ireland King Defen-
der of the faith &c Anno Dom 1698
