And I do hereby further declare & publish that as  
 I am heartily sorry there has been so much doubt & Law  
 ful Occasion given for summoning of so many persons  
 hither to give their depositions for discovery of the wicked  
 & evil Practices & attempts aforesaid so would have all  
 persons to take caution hereby to avoid giving the like  
 Occasion for the future by associating themselves or combr  
 :ing with them under this assurance that it is neither their  
 Number quality or Conditions that shall excuse them from  
 being prosecuted against according to Law

And for the Encouragement of all such his Majesty's  
 Loyal Subjects that shall endeavour the peace quiet and  
 Wellfare of this his Majesty's province by apprehending  
 & seizing the said Philip Clark & John Good Sen. in case  
 they shall not surrender themselves to Justice as hereby  
 they are required, such persons shall use a Reward therefore  
 for the apprehending them or either of them receive as a  
 Reward the Sum of twenty pounds Sterling for each of  
 them

Lastly I do hereby command the several Sheriffs of  
 this province to proclaim & publish this my proclamation  
 in all Churches Chapels Court houses & other publick pla  
 :ces of resort within their several Counties
