M^r William Stamps of Cecil County appearing
& being told of some words he had said relating upon
James Fusty Esq^r one of his Majesty's honorable Council with
in this Province the said M^r Stamps alledged that he was
Informed by one M^r Charles Bays that Esq^r Fusty reported
that his Excellency Coll^l Spilley late Gov^r of this Province
came in Government by the means of the Lord Baltimore
& that his Excellency Coll^l Nicholson his May^r present
Government meaning had a Commission from the Lord Bal-
timore or words to that Effect

Ordered that M^r Stamps give Security to prosecute
his accusation

And the said M^r Stamps nominating several persons
& praying they might be Summoned before his Excellency
the Governour & Council to prove the same

Ordered that the Sheriff of Cecil County Do sum-
mons Matthew Kamberhagen Charles Bays Tho^s Church
Ann his wife & John Willis that all sixes with a part
they be & appear before his Excellency the Gov^r in Council
the day after the next Provincial Court to give their Testi-
mony therein
