Ordered that the said Lieut Col. Henry Low take Care to have the Culvert County men employed in carrying the said Arms paid out of St Marys County Levy

Ordered that Letters be writ to Coll. John Addison Col. John Courts & Col. Henry Mitchel to send men & horses to fetch the Arms allotted for Prince Georges Charles and Culvert Countys
