Sir/ This day was read in Council here a Letter by me
received from Coll^o Jennings dated the 24th of January past
together with a warrant under your Excellency's hand &
Seal for apprehending Coll^o John Cood & upon conside-
ration thereon had it is thought Expedient for his Majesty's
Service that you would please to send one of the said War-
rants to the Sheriff of each County within your Govern-
ment with Directions & orders to the Sheriff that apprehends
him for to deliver him up to the next Justice of peace in
this Government either on the eastern or Western Shore
