 Marys County & we are obliged to declare our senti-
 ments thereupon that if his Excellency Sir Edm Andros
 his Majesty's Lieut^t & Gov^r General of Virginia
 had taken due care upon the several applications to
 him made from this Gov^t to have had the said Mr Cood
 apprehended & secured & delivered up to Justice in this
 Province the same had not happened but the defect
 therein is the occasion of these disturbances & commoti-
 ons being raised & set on foot by the said Cood & several
 other persons who bragged of their security in Virginia
