Coll<sup>d</sup> Mitchell having told his Excellency that one  
of his men had sold a sword

Ordered that enquiry be made after the arms the  
men had to the Town of Potomack

Then came Mr. Samuel Watkins naval Officer of  
Potomack & made oath to two lists of Shipping

Ordered that as soon as Captain Tanner & Captain  
Emms are cleared that Mr. Watkins & Mr. Jennings send  
their Lists; no more being expected this year & that Mr.  
Watkins swear to his lists before Captain Keetch & send it  
by Emms or Tanner

Ordered that the Clerk give notice of that the Court  
of Appeals & Writs of Error will sit on Tuesday next

And that he write to the honorable Coll<sup>d</sup> John Addison  
& Thomas Brooke Esq<sup>r</sup> to come to the Council against  
that time

Ordered that the late Sheriffs of Talbot & Somerset  
Countys take care to have the publick Tobacco ready  
against the next assembly to be paid as by the Assembly  
shall be directed

Coll<sup>d</sup> Thompsons & Mr. Vanderhuydens & Co<sup>s</sup> repre-  
sentation & Journal of their proceedings with the  
Shewanoe Susquehanna & Delaware Indians read  
& approved of & the said Indians present to his Ex<sup>cellency</sup>  
the Governor Consisting of five Deer Skins two Belts
