

That whereas the Returns made last year relating to
 Ships & seafaring men &c^s & also to Churches Chappels
 Schools & dissenters &c^s & adjudged not to be satisfactory
 & that a Commission is again repaired by the right honble
 the Lords of the Council of Trade & Plantations to have
 a more exact & perfect Acc^t sent them

Ordered therefore that the several Constables go
 about from house to house within their respective hun-
 dreds & take an exact Acc^t of all men women & Chil-
 dren & what religion & persuasion they are of also
 what ministers or priests Nonconformists Spectators or
 others they have residing within their several hundreds
 & what Churches Chappels meeting houses & other pub-
 lick places of Devotion they have & likewise what
 Schools & by whom kept all which they are to return
 in 4 several Columns in a fair Sheet of paper & a good
 legible hand

Ordered that the Sheriffs do return an acc^t of what
 Ships Boats Challopes &c^s have been built since the
 Revolution & to whom belong & what seafaring men
 are in their several Counties

Ordered that the several Sheriffs do make such
 enquiry & return an acc^t of what persons are in Offices
 who are undred unqualified by the late act of Parlia-
 ment for preventing frauds & regulating abuses in the
 Plantation trade

Ordered that the several Sheriffs give notice that
 the new School will be finished in the next spring
 & that there are two payments made to the Builders
