 their respective Salaries of One hundred Pounds p^{ann}
 for being her Maj^{ty} Receivers of the Taxes & Imposts &c^e
 within this Province for several years last past nor found
 much as that upon the prize lately brought into the
 Province by Capt^l Josiah Moore in her Majesty's Ship C^o
 find there will be sufficient of her Majesty's Share thereof
 the said George Plater's Hands to pay & satisfy their said
 Salaries that this Board would warrant the same.

In answer to which petition the Board do not believe
 it to be in their power to dispose of any part thereof but Or-
 der and direct the same to be secured for her Majesty's use
 and advise the petitioners to make application to her Maj^{ty}
 for her Royal favour therein on their Behalf.

Ordered that Geo. Plater Esq^r her Majesty's Receiver
 General in whose hands her Majesty's Share of the prize
 is pay unto the Judge Advocate Registrar & Marshall of
 the Court of Vice Admiralty their fees for the Queen's Share
 by due upon condemnation of the said Prize.

Ordered that a Commission be prepared for Major
 William Harris to be Colonel of Cecil County Col^l John
 Thompson & Lt Col^l Hans Hanson being both dead
 & that the said Col^l Harris take care to call for & secure
 the publick arms in that County.

Also Ordered that four Quarter Bands of Powder
 be sent to the said Col^l Harris for the Service of that County.

The President asks the Board if they have any thing
