sent to you by Captain Peregrine Brown the first of March last, whether  
you issued a Warrant or Warrants according to the Directions of the Act of  
Assembly, at what Time you issued them, and what Constables you charge  
with such Warrant or Warrants, whether all or any of the Persons named in the  
said Certificate have been yet brought before you, or carried before any other  
Magistrate, and what Cause each of the Persons who were brought before  
you made against marching in Obedience to Captain Browns Order: it is  
expected that you will give his Excellency and their Honours an Answer
