That the said Commissary deliver to James Beny a q m^o sold in the 7th Reg^t Disch^d Twenty nine Pounds ten shillings in Cloathing due himself and also Twenty nine Pounds ten shillings in Cloathing for the use of Joseph Abop who was a q m^o sold in the same Reg^t Discharged, due them part of a Remedy to procure Troops for the A. Army.

That the western shore Treasurer pay to Thomas Doyle Sixty five Pounds due him of Account passed by the said Genl.

That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Perry Benson of the 5th Maryland Reg^t two thousand Dollars to be expended in the Recruiting Service & also two thousand Dollars in lieu of the articles for the present year allowed by the late act of Assembly.

That the said Treasurer pay to Capt Edward Gate, ten thousand Dollars to pay the Bounty to the 2^d Battalion entered into the Continental Service by act of Assembly.

That the said Treasurer pay to the said Capt Edward Gate two thousand Dollars in lieu of the articles for the present year allowed by the late act of Assembly.
