That the said Treasurer pay to Lieut Isaac Rawlings of the Magoes Company ordered to Camp, two thousand Dollars in lieu of the articles allowed him for the present year according to the late Act of Assembly

That the said Treasurer pay to Joseph Williams one hundred and twenty six Pounds, seventeen shillings & six Pence due him per Ac<sup>t</sup> passed by the Aud. Gen<sup>l</sup>

That the Company of Issues deliver to Henry Hall of the Boat Plate 4 Bushels of Pork and 4 of Flour for the Magoes in Baltimore
