That the said Treasurer pay to Com^o Thomas Gason Three hundred and seven Pounds, sixteen shillings to purchase Plank for the use of the State on account

Ordered that the western shew Treasurer pay to Alexander Gontee Hanson Esq. Two hundred and thirty four Pounds, seven shillings and six Pence due him & Co^o passed by the Dep^y Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to the said Alexander Gontee Hanson Judge of the General Court five hundred Pounds of Advance according to a Resolve of the Gen^l Assembly

That the said Treasurer pay to William Godsmith three hundred and sixty eight Pounds five shillings & six pence passed by the Aud. Gen^l

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Capt. Gale 1st Leather Brushes for the use of his Comp^y

On the Petition of Charles Daly who was invited to serve as a Marine in the Service of this State setting forth that he hath been for almost three years incessantly in the Hospital so much that he has not been able to perform his Duty and Com^o Gason informing the Governor and Council that the facts aforesaid as set forth in his Petition were true, It is ordered that the said Charles Daly be discharged from the service

Col.
