Edward Sims of Charles County in the State of Maryland is appointed
Ensign in the 1st Maryland Regiment of Continental Troops and it is requested that a Commission
may issue to him accordingly from the Board of War. —

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to George Dickson Twenty seven
Pounds and two hundred and twenty four Pounds, Eighteen Shillings and Three Pence for the
use of Capt Richard Staff and the Guard over the Magazine near Frederick Town and
Twenty three Pounds sixteen Shillings for the use of Capt John Shield and his Company
guarding the Convention Troops thro' Maryland & a^o passed by the Aud. Gen. & Dep^y Aud.

That the said Treasurer pay to the said George Dickson Twenty four Pounds
ten Shillings for the use of Peter Baker a 9th Mo Sold in the 6th Regiment Discharged
being the balance due him in lieu of Clothing allowed by the Act of Assembly to procure
Troops for the American Army and also the further Sum of two hundred Pounds to be
delivered over to Capt Richard Staff to be applied in procuring Provisions for the Guard
over the Magazine near Frederick Town on Account

That the said Treasurer pay to Commodore Thomas Graison one hundred
Pounds on Account

Monday 13th September 1779

Present as on Saturday —

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Lieut Edward Wright of the
7th Regiment two thousand Dollars in lieu of the Articles for the present Year allowed by
the late Act of Assembly —

That the said Treasurer pay to his Excellency Thomas Johnson Esq^r two
hundred and Eight Pounds, six Shillings & Eight Pence due him for 1^{mo} A^o as Governor

The Commission of Charles Beatty from John Cox Assistant Quarter Master
Gen^l of the 10 April 1778 & Commissioning & appointing him the said Charles Beatty to act
to and perform all and singular the Business of Dep^y Quarter Master General with the
privilege of making Purchases in the County of Frederick, of Horses, Waggons and such
other Articles as he may from Time to Time be instructed by the Quarter Master General, the
Assistant Quarter Master General or either of them to procure & being produced to this Board
