That the said Treasurer pay to William Army seven thousand nine hundred and seventy two Pounds, thirteen shillings and three pence & sixteen Pounds, ten shillings due himself also four Pounds, ten shillings for the use of William Briscoe, thirty Pounds, for the use of Spencer Beale, thirty eight Pounds, ten shillings for the use of William Dollaj, one Pound for the use of Ebenezer Reyner per Account passed by the Aud.
