Present as on yesterday —

Ordered that the Commissary of Stores deliver to William Samuel late a 9 month Soldier in the 5th Maryland Regiment Discharged the amount of Twenty nine Pounds, ten shillings in Cloathing due him by an Act of Assembly to procure Troops for the American Army —

Saturday 2^d October 1779

Present as on yesterday —

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Robert Key Twenty six Pounds, sixteen shillings per Account passed by the Depy Aud. —

That the said Treasurer pay to Thomas Beatty Thirty three Pounds, Thirty six Pounds, and Thirty Pounds, fifteen shillings for the use of Capt Richard Haff and the 9th Magazine near Frederick Town. That the said Treasurer pay to Richard Dallam Esq. Sixty Eight Pounds, nine shillings and four Pence for the use of Samuel Smith per Account passed by the Depy Aud. —

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Nicholas Farnance a 9 mo. Soldier in the 6th Regimt. Discharged the amount of Twenty six Pounds in Cloathing for himself and also Ten Pounds in Cloathing for the use of Christo Curtis a 9 mo. Sold. in the same Regimt. Discharged due them according to the Act of Assembly to procure Troops for the American Army —
