Commission issued to Alexander Blaggett elected Sheriff of Washington County

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Elio Valle the seventy seven Pounds five Shillings due him for Account passed by the Aud. Gen^l

That the said Treasurer pay to Jacob Dusby four Pounds fourteen Shillings and four Pence half penny due him for Account passed by the Aud. Gen^l

Permission is hereby granted to Lads on board the Schooner Cambridge of the Battalion of Fifty Tons or thereabouts belonging to Joseph Dawson & Company a Cargo of Flour Potatoes Turneps and other Vegetables and the same to clear out and transport in her to and for the Use of the Fleet and Army of his most Christian Majesty the Captain of the said Schooner previous to his Lading on Board any of the said Articles giving Bond payable to this State in the Penalty of Fifteen thousand Pounds conditioned that if the said Cargo shall be delivered on board the Fleet of his most Christian Majesty the Danger of the Sea and Enemies only excepted and shall within four Months from the Date of such Bond produce to the Governor and Council of this State a Certificate under the Hand of a Captain or Commanding Officer of some one of the Ships of War of the said Fleet or some Officer of the said Fleet of higher Rank of such Delivery then such Bond to be void else of Full force, and the Captain of the said Schooner also making Oath before the Naval Officer who shall clear out the said Vessel at or before the Time of her clearing out that he will use his utmost Endeavour to prevent the said Cargo or any part thereof falling into the Hands of the Enemy and will deliver the same if in his power to or on board some of the said Fleet.
