

Wednesday 27 October 1779

Present as on yesterday

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Lieut John Jeremiah Jacob two thousand Dollars to be delivered over to the 2^d & 4th Armstrong Captains to Gen Gist's Brigade in lieu of the Article for the present year allowed by the Act of Assembly

By General Gist's Return of the 2^d & Maryland Brigade Sept^r 18th 1779 the non Commis^d Officers and Privates are Second Regim^t 392 @ 20 £ each 7840
 4th Regim^t 418 and the 6th Regim^t 305 14,560

There were a number of Recruits expected allow 10 Men for each 600 £22,900

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Lieut John Jeremiah Jacob Twenty two thousand nine hundred Pounds, six thousand three hundred Pounds part thereof to be retained by him as Paymaster to the 6th Regim^t. Eight thousand and forty Pounds other part thereof he is to pay over to Capt Wilburn Williams Paymaster to the 2^d & the residue being Eight thousand five hundred and Sixty Pounds he is to pay over to Lieut John Hamilton Paymaster to the 4th & Maryland Regim^t to be by the said Paymasters delivered over to the non commissioned Officers & Privates of those Regiments.

That the said Treasurer pay to the said Lieut John Jeremiah Jacob two thousand Dollars to be delivered over to Brigadier Gen Gist the all^d made him by the 7th Assembly

Summons issued to Abraham Whitacre, Benjamin Bradford & Son, John Selby, Walter Taylor, William Wells, David & William & Obediah Pritchard of Harford County to testify on the Hearing of the Complaint of Thomas Doney complaining of an undue and irregular Election of Sheriffs for Harford County

Lieut Thomas Cromwell is appointed Capt Lieut to the 4th & Maryland Regiment

John Hamilton first Lieut and John Randall Ensign in the same Regt

Samuel Hamilton is appointed Ensign in the 6th Regim^t

Capt Lieut Benjamin Price is appointed Capt. in the 2^d & Maryland Regim^t

Lt John Gaspaway is appointed Capt Lieut in same Regim^t

William Woolford is appointed a first Lieut in do

Thomas & Boyd Son of Abraham Ensign in do

Zedekiah Moore is app^d Ensign in do and

Edmund Compton is app^d an Ensign in the 1st Maryland Regiment

This Board do approve the above Appointments and request Commissions may issue accordingly from the Board of War
