James & Martin, William Howey, Leon Handy & Nathaniel Potter, Licensed separately appointed by Gen^l Theo. Wederhandt Assistant Commissary of Purchases under a Commission from Ephraim Blaine, as Deputies under said Lt. Wederhandt. —

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Col^l & Command Bruce three hundred Pounds to be delivered over to Capt. Richard Staff for the use of the Militia Guard over the Magazine near Fredericks^{town} and to be accounted for

That the said Treasurer pay to John Woolf six Pounds to be delivered over to Alexander Ogg, the Bounty allowed by the General Assembly for enlisting one Recruit —

That the said Treasurer pay to Daniel Canoll Esquire five hundred and forty Pounds on Account —

William Pendergast who was Commissary of the 1st Maryland Brigade is appointed Ensign in the 5th Maryland Regiment & Jacob Mitinger who was a Lieut of Horse in the Marine-Chasseur Corps is appointed Ensign in the 3rd Maryland Regiment and it is requested that Com^rmissions may issue to them accordingly from the Board of War —

The Petition of Thomas Hopkins of Talbot County complaining of an undue and unfair Election of Sheriff for said County having this Day been presented to the Governor Council It is ordered that a Copy of said Petition and the distⁿ therein referred to & lodged therewith and of this order be served on John Needles in the said Petition mentioned on or before Tuesday the 2^d Day of November next and that Saturday the 13th Day of November next be appointed for a hearing on the said Petition and that such Summons as shall be applied for by either Party issue for Witnesses —

Ordered that the western shore Treasurer pay to Robert Reith Trinity six Pounds, nine shillings and two pence for 2 1/2 Months Salary as a Messenger to the Governor Council to the 7th Novemb^r next being the end of his year and also the further Sum of Fifteen Pounds in Advances according to a Resolution of the General Assembly —
