Commission is hereby given the Honorable William Pava Esq^r to draw from the Farm and Plantation in Queen Anne County, such supplies of the Produce raised thereon as may be necessary for the Subsistence of himself and Family during their Residence in Philadelphia agreeably to the Act of a Assembly "Entitled an Act to prohibit for a limited time, the Exportation of Wheat, Flour, Rye, Indian Corn, rice, Bread, Beef, Pork Bacon, Live Stock, peas, beans, Oats and other Natural."

That the said Treasurer pay to Francis Daltam eight thousand Dollars to be delivered over to Col. Richard Daltam to be expended in the Purchase of Wheat & flour for the use of the Continental Army and accounted for.

Sir, By Virtue of the Resolution of Congress of the 7th Day of Oct^r 1779 and this Order pay to Francis Daltam, twelve thousand Dollars to be by him delivered over to Col. Richard Daltam for the Purchase of Flour & Wheat for the Continental Army.
