Ordered That the Eastern shew Treasurer pay to Henry Dickinson, Two hundred and eighty nine Pounds, five shillings due him per account passed by the Aud. Genl.

That the western shew Treasurer pay to Thomas Johnson Esq. Two hundred Pounds for 4 Months Salary as is to the gov. Remitt to the 1<sup>st</sup> Inst.

That the Commissary of Stores deliver to Col. Forest 2<sup>rs</sup> French hose and scammel stuff for 3 miles waatecoats, he paying the current Price for them.

Nicholas Worthington, a John Dugm and a Nicholas a Haubbin Esq. Esquires Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County certify that agreeable to an Act of Assembly entitled "an Act for the more effectual preventing forestalling and Engrossing and for other Purposes therein mentioned" have seized one a Leewards Load of Wheat, in the Possession of Francis Baker, which from Information contains about the Quantity of five hundred Bushels and have delivered the same to Conrad Theodore Wiedershandt Commissary of Purchases for the United States.

Permission is hereby given to a Mr. Lane Galdelough of this State to solicit Leave from his Excellency General Washington or the commanding Officer at the Bat. Posts of the American Army at Elizabeth Town to go into the city of New York, not to return again into this State during the present War, between America and Great Britain, without Leave of the Governor and Council for the time being, first had and obtained, with Liberty to take his Child with her, and John Stewart a Minor and Permission is likewise given to Mr. John Turnbull of this State, who has given Evidence of his Attachment to America to attend Mr. Galdelough as far as the American Lines.

Ordered that the western shew Treasurer pay to Capt. Beriah Maybury, One hundred and twenty five Pounds, two shillings and six Pence due him per account passed by the Depy Aud. and also the further Sum of one hundred and fifty Pounds on account.

That the said Treasurer pay to William Goldsmith one thousand and seventy eight Pounds, ten shillings due him per account passed by the Aud. Genl.

Mr. Wiedershandt is hereby requested and authorized to purchase from 12 to 15000 lbs of good Grass seed Beef if to be had at 7/6 q<sup>rs</sup> for the use of the state of Maryland and he is likewise desired to advise this Board as soon as he has executed this Commission that Inconveniences may be avoided in transporting the Beef further.
