Whereas the House of Senate stands adjourned to the twenty ninth Day of
March next and the House of Delegates to the first Day of the same Month and Affairs
of Importance requiring the Consideration of the General Assembly as soon as well may be
have thought proper, that the General Assembly of this State should meet on the second Day
of March next, and do therefore In virtue of the Power with which I am invested by the
Constitution and Form of Government hereby appoint the said second Day of March for
the Meeting and holding the General Assembly, of which the several Sheriffs of this State
are hereby enjoined to give Public and Due notice.

Given at Annapolis this third day of February in the Year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and eighty.
