That the said Commissary of Stores deliver to Patrick Carvery green Cloth suff^t for 10 Suits of Cloath and 20 Shirts 10th Stockings and 10th Shoes to be delivered over to Lieut. & Capt. Magruder of the 3^d Reg^t for the Recruits enlisted by him to be charged to him till he produces Receipts for the Delivery of them

That the Collector of the Tax for Saint Marys County pay to Lieut. & Capt. Magruder of the 3^d Reg^t three thousand Dollars to be expended in the Recruits Enrolment and accounted for
